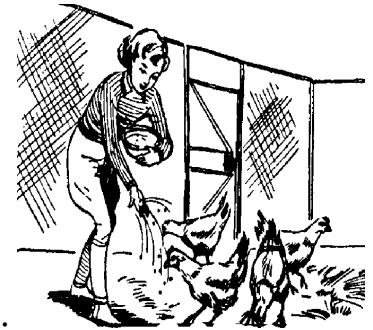
Order Your Chickens

NOTE: All poultry orders have to be paid at the time you order.

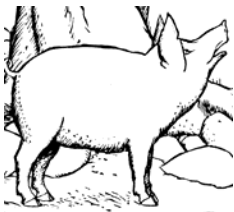


State Swine Tag Orders Due

Barrows — (Show at Major & County Shows): State Swine tag orders for Barrows need to be turned into the Extension office by Friday, September 18th. Tags cost \$8.00 each.

Gilts — (Show at County Show): You do not need to turn in a tag order. County Validation Tags cost \$2.00 each due after validation.

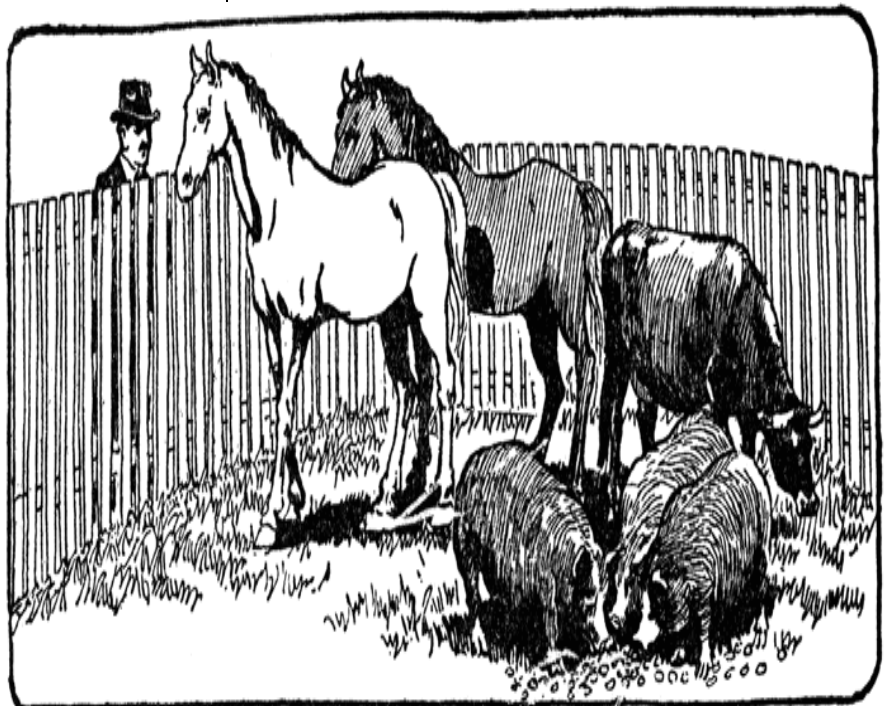

County Food Workshop Could You Be The Next Iron Chef?

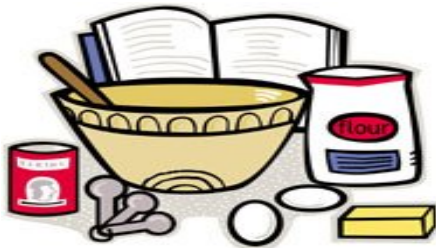

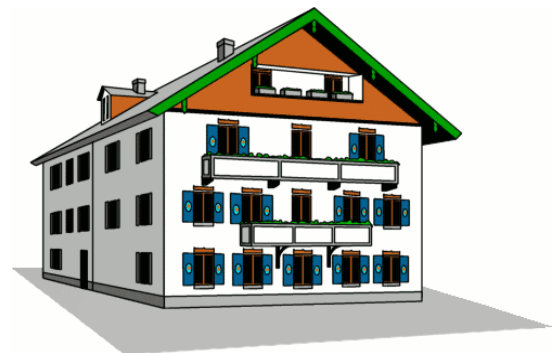
