

Wether Lambs & Wether Goats

(Major & County Shows): State Validation Tags MUST be ordered by August 17th. State Validation Tags cost \$15 each. These tags need to be paid for when you place your order.

Ewe Lambs & Nanny Goats

(County Show only): If you plan to show a Ewe Lamb and/or Nanny Goat during the Nolan County Jr. Livestock Show you will need to validate your animal with a County Validation Tag. You do NEED to turn in a tag order. Remember: State Validation Tags or Wether Lambs and/or Wether Goats MUST be

ordered by Friday, August 17th.

<u>RED, WHITE & BLUE SALAD!</u>

- 3 cups watermelon, cut into 1 inch cubes and seeded
- 1 cup blueberries
- 2 medium bananas, sliced
- 1 cup fat-free whipped topping

Juice of 1 lime

1. Wash your hands and clean your cooking area.

2. Wash all the fruit.

3. Cut watermelon into cubes, remove seeding.

4. Place cut watermelon and blueberries in medium bowl.

5. Slice bananas and place in a small bowl.

6. Squeeze lime juice over bananas and mix, covering all bananas.

7. Add bananas and whipped topping to the watermelon and blueberries and mix well.

8. Chill until ready to serve.
